Resume Building on Naviance

A resume is a document that presents a person's background, skills and accomplishments.

It includes:

- ★ Personal Information
 - Name, phone number, email address
- **★** Education
 - High school years and name of the high school or high schools you attended
 - Relevant Coursework (AP's, GPA, DE, etc.)
- ★ Work History
 - Company, Job Title, Responsibilities and the dates you worked there
- ★ Volunteer Work/Community Service/Extracurricular Activities
 - Where was the work done/what did you do and what was your role
- ★ Skills/Certifications/Awards/Accomplishments
 - Skills Relevancy (major in college, job you are applying for)
 - In or outside of school Accomplishments (Sports, ROTC awards, etc.)
