PSAT Administration

- NQHS and QHS administered the PSAT to approximately
 550 students on Tuesday, January 26th
- First standardized testing since November of 2019
- Very successful and well attended
- Scores will be released on March 8th and students will receive an email on how to access them

SAT and AP Update

- NQHS & QHS are offering a school-day SAT on Tuesday, April 27
- Registration https://regismart.net/
- The cost for the SAT without the essay is \$52 (If you are eligible for free/reduced lunch, your exam will cost \$10)
- The cost for SAT with essay is \$68 (If you are eligible for free/reduced lunch, your exam will cost \$17)
- Deadline to register for the NQHS School Day SAT is March 5, 2021
- April 27th will be a remote learning day for all other students
- The March 13th and May 8th SAT administration at NQHS are cancelled
- AP exams will likely be in person and we are hoping to make them optional for this year only (more details will be coming soon)

What has changed with SAT and ACT in Admissions?

- Many colleges were test-optional for 2021- 22 applications -- which means that students can choose to apply without submitting test scores; some have chosen to remain test optional
- Website to find out which schools are test optional: <u>www.fairtest.org</u>
- Make sure to check requirements for each school, as some schools may have other requirements
- The College Board is no longer offering SAT Subject tests
- The College Board will discontinue the optional SAT Essay after the June 2021 administration

Classroom presentations for 10th and 11th graders

- The guidance department met with all 10th graders and assisted them in an interest inventory to help learn about career planning.
 They were registered on Naviance and completed an assessment to help them start thinking about college majors and career options
- We are beginning 11th grade presentations on March 15th where we have a presentation on college and career planning for all students
- Counselors encourage our students to set up individual post-graduate planning meetings beginning in late March/April
