### **Dual Enrollment with Quincy College**

Dual enrollment is a partnership that Quincy Public School participates in which provides 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students the opportunity to earn college credit from Quincy College by taking honors level courses listed on this slide.

Dual enrollment students receive a Quincy College transcript upon completion of their dual enrollment course(s). As long as the student earns a final grade of a "C" or better, then they will receive Quincy College credit for their dual enrollment course(s).

The cost for each course is \$250 and students have the option of receiving college credit from many other four year colleges while still in high school.
